Marco V. Ávila, P.E. is a registered Professional Engineer (P.E.) in the State of Maryland. He has been practicing his Civil Engineering Profession for over 36 years (23 Years with WSP/Parsons Brinckerhoff). He has experience providing engineering and program/project management services for major infrastructure projects in the public and private sector; including transit, highways, bridges, Public-Private Partnership (P3) and telecommunications. He has a consistent track record of cost-effective project delivery under demanding circumstances. Marco is fluent in Spanish and speaks Portuguese.

While working as a Director/Civil Engineer/Program Manager for WSP-USA, Marco has gained the trust of his clients and peers. Apart from loving engineering, Marco is an active member of local chapters of several societies; including American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE), American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), American Council of Engineering Companies-Maryland (ACEC/MD), The Engineering Society of Baltimore (ESB), Engineers Without Borders, and Maryland Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (MDHCC), Advisory Council for St. Jude-Baltimore, Board Member at Sail Baltimore.



Apart from the engineering world, Marco dedicates his free time to volunteer in other organizations. Marco is currently the Chairman of the Board and President of the **Maryland Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (MDHCC)**. He took over MDHCC in April 2019 and his term will be three (3) years. With the help of the new leadership at the Chamber, Marco has big plans for the Chamber including bringing the membership from 375 members to 1,000 members by the end of his term. The new programs that he created and



implemented for the MDHCC members include: Mentoring, Educations, Growth, Partnership, Promotion/Marketing, Procurement Advisory, International Business Marketing and Networking. In addition, Marco and his team created the NEW Maryland Hispanic Chamber Scholarship Program. The Scholarship Program will provide scholarships for high school students, college student, graduate students, trade School students and special charitable projects. Organizations will have the opportunity to team up with the MDHCC to provide these scholarships. Furthermore, Marco plans to bring more businesses to Maryland from all over Latin America through the Maryland Sister States Program (in partnership with the Maryland Secretary of State office).



Marco is a Past President of the Engineering Society of Baltimore (ESB) (2016-2017). In his term, he was able to bring ESB to a new level by increasing membership by 200 new members and 10 new Societies to a total of 550 members. He also led the approval and execution of one of the biggest ESB Capital Project (The Construction of ESB's Elevator Tower). The goal was to bring the ESB building to be ADA Compliance. After serving as the President of the **Engineering Society of Baltimore**, Marco committed to continue serving as a Board Member and as one of the Trustees of the **ESB Education Foundation**. The main purpose of the ESB Education Foundation is to provide annual scholarships to talented future engineers. He also Chair's ESB's Annual **Engineers Week Program**. Over 1500 High School Students throughout Maryland participate in the Annual Engineers Week Program and the Engineering Challenges to learn more about the wonderful world of engineering and the **STEM Program**.



Marco is currently serving his fourth year in a committee Chair at the **American Council of Engineering Companies / Maryland (ACEC/MD)**.



Marco is a Past President of the **American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) Chesapeake Section** (2010-2011). He was the Co-Chair of the **ASHE National Conference in Baltimore, Maryland-2015**. Marco also is part of the team coordinating ASHE's monthly technical engineering meeting/seminars.

He also assists in raising scholarship funds to benefit local students that are pursuing engineering in various Maryland Universities (University of Maryland, Morgan State University and Johns Hopkins University). He continues serving on the board and he is currently leading the Professional Development Hours (PDH) Certifications Program.



Marco is the CEO and Co-Founder of **The Healing Hands Foundation (THHF)**. Marco has been volunteering for more than twenty-six (26) years organizing medical and dental missions to help children in need for free around the world. He is dedicated to helping children with complex congenital malformations in areas lacking resources and surgical expertise. Additionally, Marco led the Covid-19 Pandemic efforts by coordinating the donations of medical supplies for Ecuador, Guatemala, Honduras. Ecuador received 20 Tons of medical supplies donated by THHF partners, Guatemala received 10 Tons of medical supplies, Honduras received 2 Tons of PPE. (Other countries will follow). Because of Sail Baltimore's efforts to bring ships to Baltimore, visitors are able to board and tour unique ships, learn about different cultures, interact with people from around the world, and learn about navigation, geography, technology, maritime history and more.

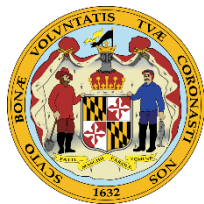


Leadership Baltimore County: Class of 2021
